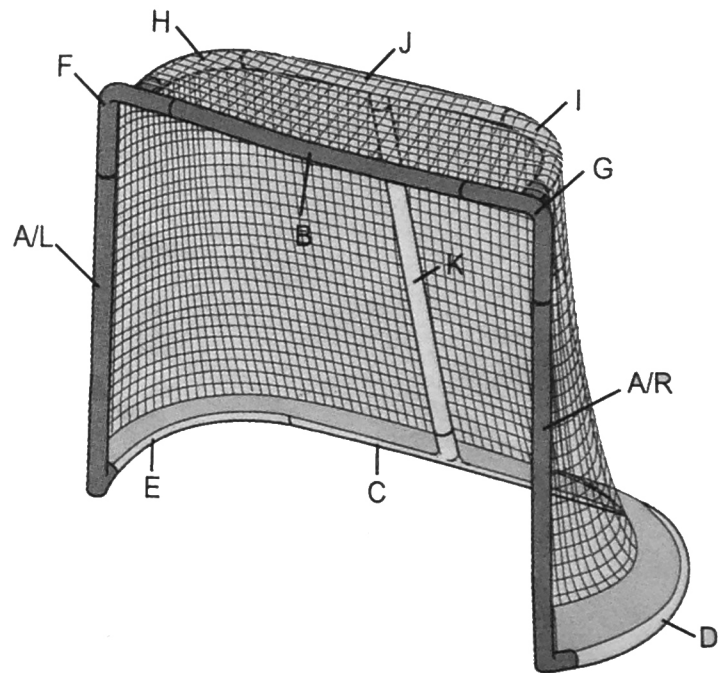


Hockey Goal

Assembly Instructions

Parts List:

- A/L- Goal post (Left)
- A/R - Goal post (Right)
- B - Upper front crossbar bar
- C - Lower rear crossbar
- D - Right lower rear corner
- E - Left lower rear corner
- F - Left upper front corner
- G - Right upper front corner
- H - Left "U" corner
- I - Right "U" corner
- J - Centre "U" crossbar
- K - Back brace
- L - Mesh
- M - lacing
- N - Plastic caps (2)



Assembly Instructions:

- 1 Remove all parts from package and make sure all the parts are present.
- 2 Click one goal post(A/L) to left lower rear corner (E), then the other goal post (A/R) to the right lower rear corner (D).
- 3 Click the bottom of the back brace(K) to the lower rear crossbar(C)
- 4 Snap the lower rear crossbar(C) to the 2 lower rear corners (D,E). The lower part of the goal is finished.
- 5 Click the front pieces together (B,G,F) , then assemble the "U" pieces together (I,J,H).
- 6 Assemble the already connected front pieces (B,G,F) to the "U" pieces (I,J,H) . The very top part of the goal is now finished.
- 7 The last step is to connect the very top part of the goal to the already assembled lower part of the goal. [Make sure the left front corner (F) and the right corner (G) snaps into the goal posts (A/L, A/R), and the top of the back brace (K) snaps to the "U" pieces simultaneously.
- 8 Insert the plastic caps (N) into the bottom of the goal posts (A/L, A/R).
- 9 Align three red tags on the mesh with left, center and right of upper front crossbar and drape over the frame.
- 10 Lace the mesh(L) with lacing string (M) starting at top center and working down and around. Easy lace system to the back of the goal.
