Dear Archer:

Thank you for your purchase. The Fang™ by COYOTL® is more rigid than a conventional nock. Therefore, string fit is very important. Test fit the nock on your string before bringing the arrow to full draw. You can just press on and pull off even before you add them to your arrow shafts. Do not use them in compound bows.

The Fang™ isn't as flexible as conventional nocks, so if it is really tight it could create a dangerous condition. If your string is fat, you can use a different string or you can remove material from the nock using a tool specific for that purpose, sand paper, or an inexpensive emery board readily available at pharmacies or where healthcare products are sold.

The Fang™ will not fit into a fletching jig. For insert nocks, fletch using conventional nocks. Then, remove the nocks, insert the new nocks, and align with the feathers. For glue on nocks, use blue painter's tape to affix conventional nocks to the shaft. Fletch as normal. Remove the tape and conventional nock, glue on the Fang™, and align with the feathers. The Fang™ has been designed to work best on Flemish twist strings made from 15 strands of b50 Dacron served with .026 inch diameter Diamondback serving. These can be purchased from my website at www.COYOTL.com and from many other archery suppliers.
