2/3 yard of 4390 APPLE

1 yard of 5268 BLACK

Backing:

3 1/2 yards of 5268 BLACK

1/2 yard of 5265 SMOKE

Fabric B:

1/2 yard of 5266 MOCHA

1/2 yard of 5267 NEUTRAL

Fabric D:

1 yard of M4875 WILLOW

Fabric E:

1 yard of M4875 COIN

Fabric F:

2/3 yard of M4875 FOG

Fabric G:

1 yard of 5268 CREAM

Fabric H:

3/4 yard of M4875 BANANA

Backing:

3-1/2 yards of 5268 CREAM

Cutting:

Fabric A: Cut five 8 1/2" squares.

Fabric B: Cut five 8 1/2" squares.

Fabric C: Cut six 2" x 40 1/2" strips.

Fabric D: Cut forty 4 1/2" squares. See instructions to cut six small balls of yarn.

Fabric E: Cut three 1 1/2" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strips. Piece the strips together to make two 1 1/2" x 43 1/2" strips. Cut two 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips. Cut six 2 1/4" x WOF strips for binding. See instructions to cut three large balls of yarn.

Fabric F: Cut six 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make two 1 1/2" x 45 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips. See instructions to cut three large balls of yarn.

Fabric G: Cut six 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make two 4 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips and two 4 1/2" x 47 1/2" strips.

Fabric H: Cut three 6 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips.

Backing: Sew into one 55" x 68" piece for the backing.

You will also need: Fabric Pencil, Matching #8 Pearl Cotton Threads, Tapestry Needles & Fusible Web

Quilt Top Assembly Instructions:

- Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace listed number of templates onto the paper side of the fusible web. Trace the dotted lines on each ball of yarn onto the fusible web. Roughly cut out the shapes outside the drawn lines and press to the back side of the listed fabrics. Cut out each shape on the drawn line. Using a light box or window, trace the dotted lines onto the front of the fabric with a fabric pencil.
- Press fusible web onto the back side of the remaining yarn fabrics. Cut enough 3/8" wide strips on the bias to sew together into three 3/8" x 34" bias strips for Fabric E and F yarn. Cut enough 3/8" strips from Fabric D to make four 3/8" x 23" bias strips and two 3/8" x 48" bias strips for the Fabric D yarn.
- Refer to the quilt photo and position the Fabric E and F 3/8" x 34" bias strips, gently curving them in place and the Fabric E and F balls of yarn on each 6 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric H strip. Press in place to make three 6 1/2" x 40 1/2" Yarn rows.
- Finish the raw edges of the appliques with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch. Using the Pearl Cotton thread and needle to back stitch along the drawn lines on each ball of yarn to add texture.
- To make one Cat block, place one 4 1/2" Fabric D square to the top left corner of one 8 1/2" Fabric A square, right sides together (fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 4 1/2" Fabric D square to each of the remaining corners of the 8 1/2" Fabric A square to make one 8 1/2" Fabric A Cat block. Make five Fabric A Cat Blocks total.
- Repeat Steps 5-6 to make five 8 1/2" Fabric B Cat Blocks total.
- Starting and ending with one Fabric A Cat Block, sew together three Fabric A Cat blocks and two Fabric B cat blocks to make the top 8 1/2" x 40 1/2" pieced row.
- Starting and ending with one Fabric B Cat Block, sew together three Fabric B Cat blocks and two Fabric A cat blocks to make the Bottom 8 1/2" x 40 1/2" pieced row.
- Refer to the quilt photo to sew the, two pieced rows, three yarn rows and six 2" x 40 1/2" Fabric C rows to make the quilt top.
- Sew one 1 1/2" x 43 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew one 1 1/2" x 45 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew one 4 1/2" x 47 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 4 1/2" x 52 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Refer to the quilt photo for placement and arrange the six small balls of yarn and the Fabric D bias strips around the border.
- Repeat Step 4 to finish the edges and stitch the lines in place.
- Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

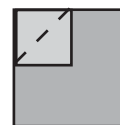

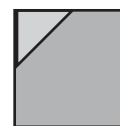
