

BOND INSTALLATION GUIDE



BOND COMPONENTS

1. Shelf
2. End shelf
5. 2 cm end pin
6. 10 cm round bar
7. 25 cm round bar
8. 35 cm round bar
2. Ceiling & Floor screw (6 mm M6)
3. Double ended screw
4. Wall bracket

You will also need (not included):

Plugs for ceiling & floor screw, suitable for your ceiling or floor (consult a hardware store if unsure).

Screws and plugs for wall brackets.

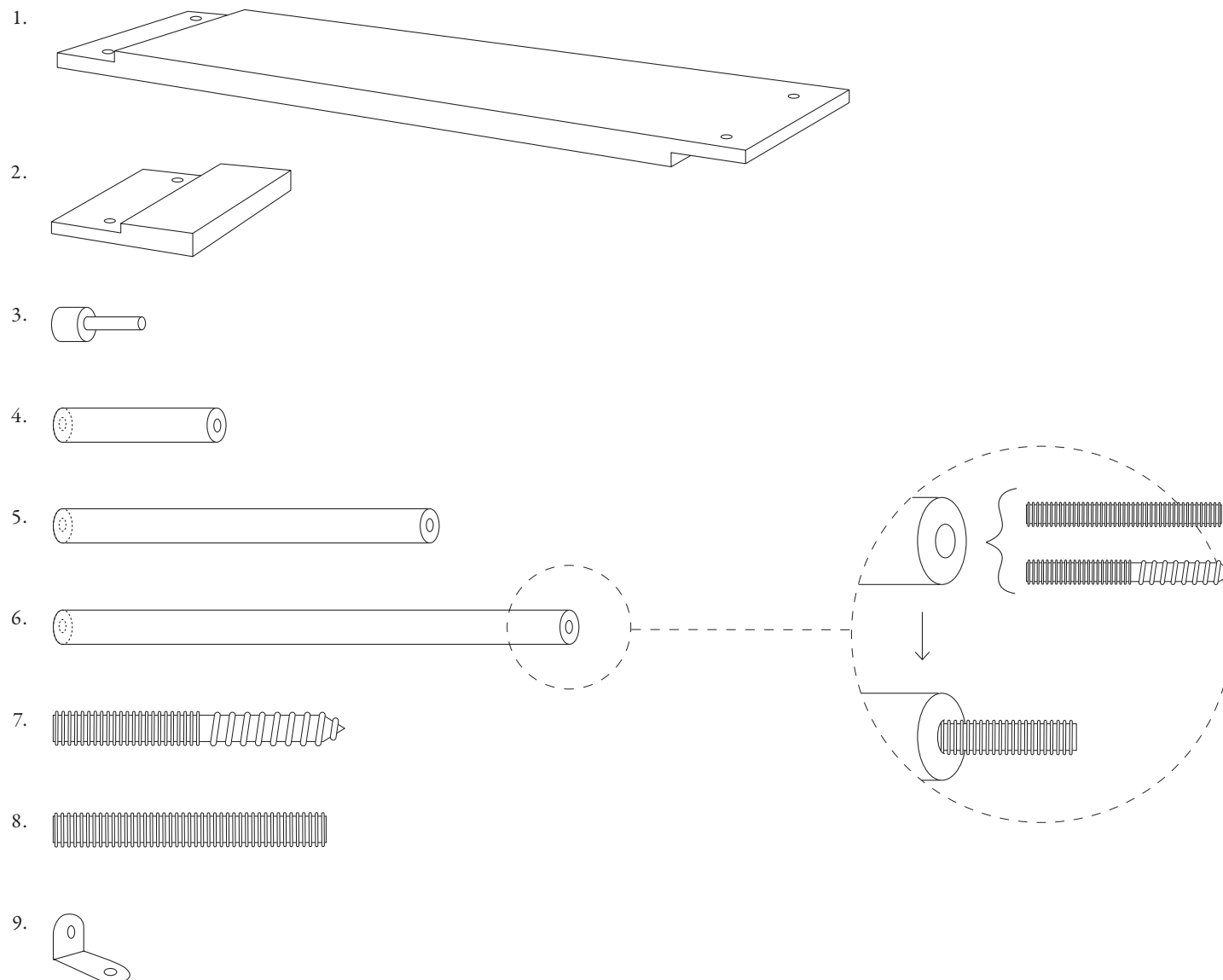
Drill with suitable drill bits.

NOTE:

You will need to attach Bond's double ended screws to the round bars before assembling, as shown below.

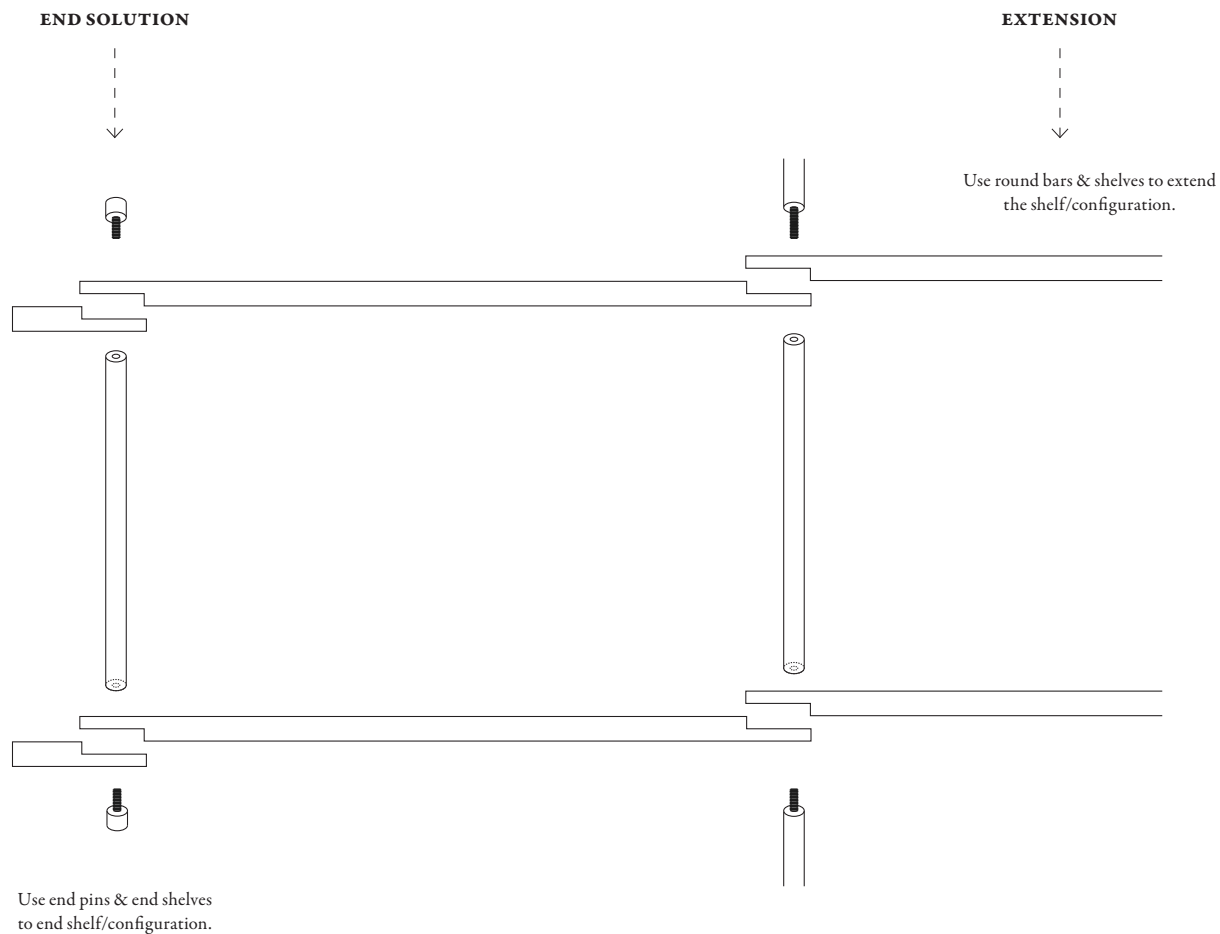
Assembling shelves with more than two sections, requires two people or more.

The customer, client or installer is responsible for properly mounting the Bond wall brackets and using the proper wall/ceiling plugs and screws.



ASSEMBLING THE SHELF

With just a few components, Bond can easily be assembled in seconds, entirely tool-free, allowing you to build and re-build it as many times as you like.



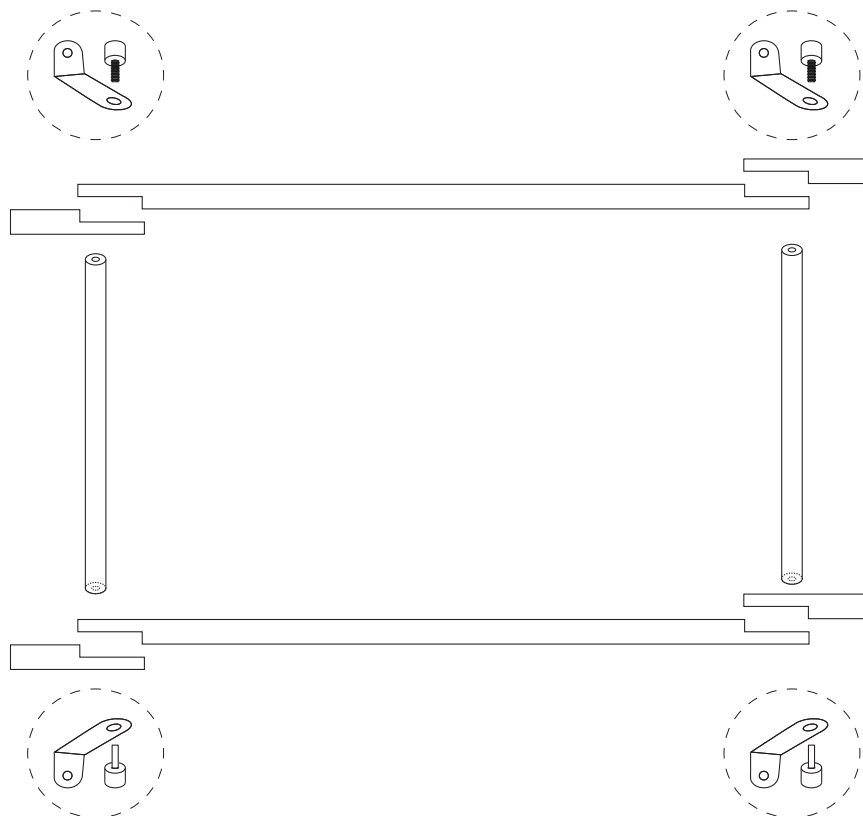
WALL MOUNTED CONFIGURATION

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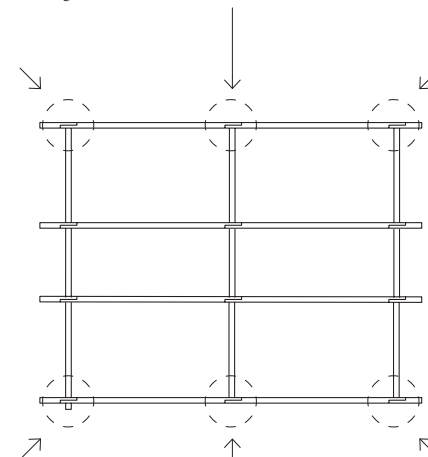


WALL MOUNTING

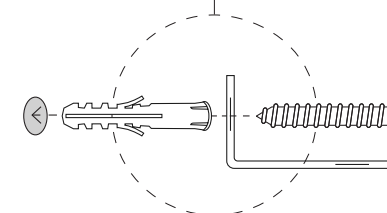
Choosing the wall as a canvas creates a nice and clear frame for both the shelf and elements around.



Place the wall brackets where they are the least visible.
On the upper side of the shelf for the upper shelves of the
configuration, and on the underside for the lower shelves.



Placement wall brackets



Attach wall bracket with screw & plug.

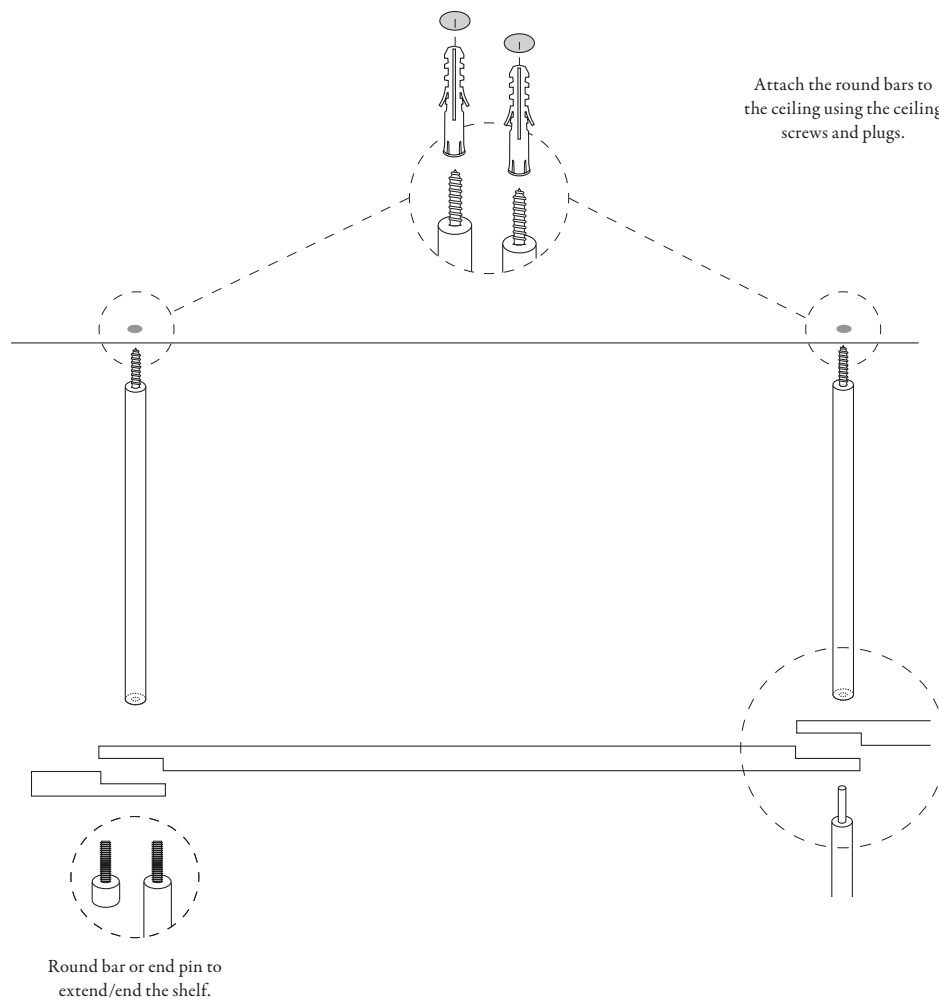
CEILING MOUNTED CONFIGURATION

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CEILING MOUNTING

Ceiling mounting opens up a range of creative ways to store items without taking up precious floor space



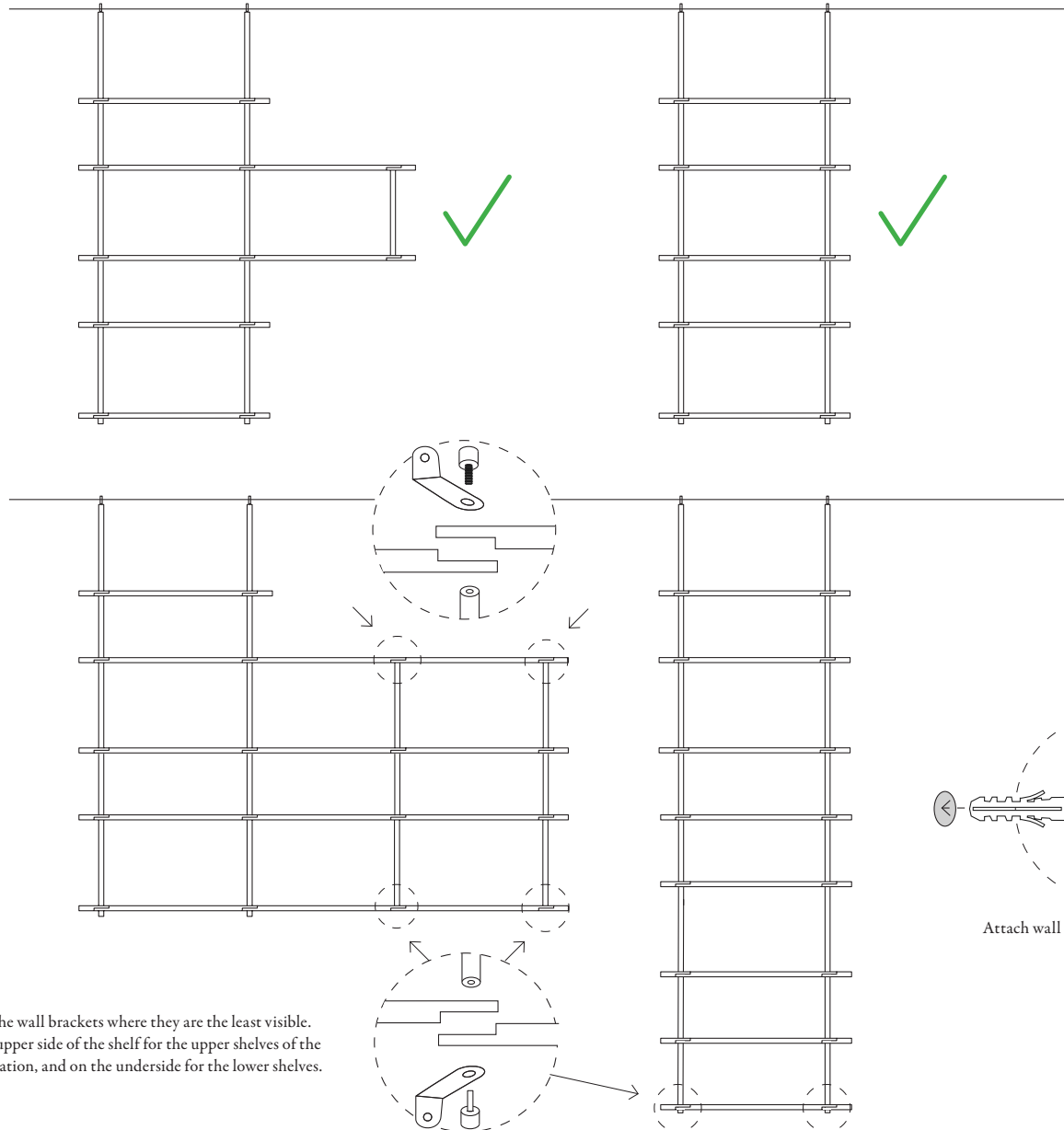


DON'T CLIMB!
Bond is not built for climbing.

CEILING MOUNTING

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For ceiling mounted Bond configurations higher than six shelves, wall brackets should be used for extra support. Please note: a ceiling mounted Bond can only support one overhang section without additional wall support/brackets.



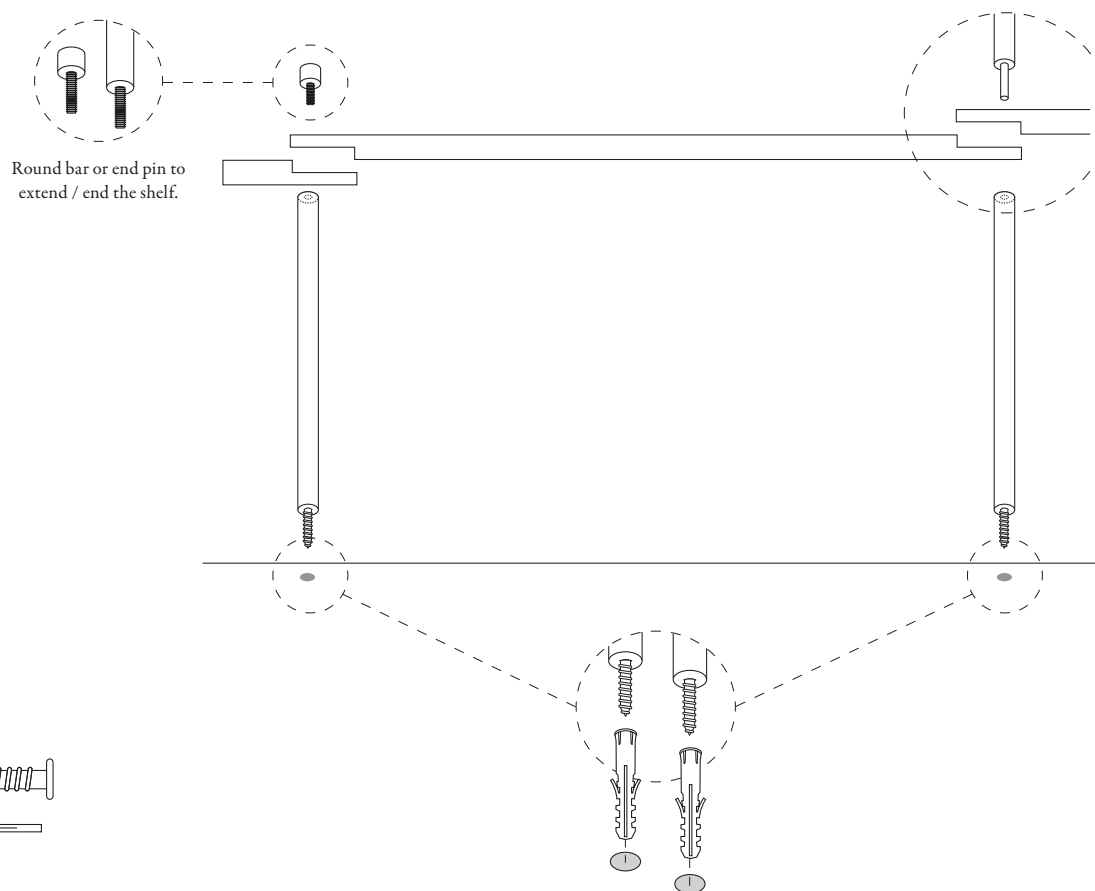
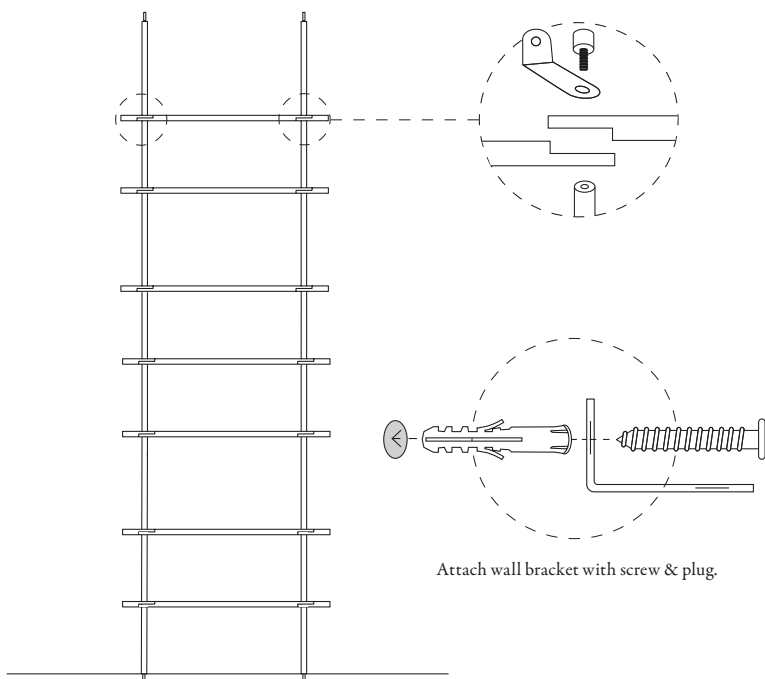
FLOOR MOUNTED CONFIGURATION

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FLOOR MOUNTING

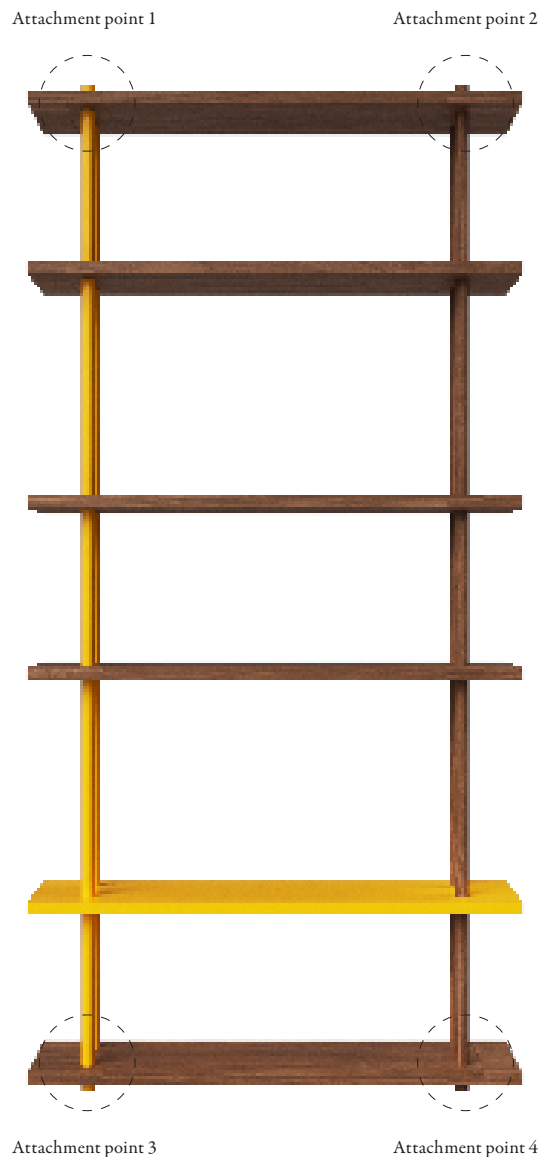
Add wall brackets for extra stability, if the configuration is higher than four shelves. Place the wall brackets where they are the least visible. On the upper shelves of the configuration, and on the underside for the lower shelves.



WEIGHT CAPACITY

The weight capacity is 20 kg (44 lbs) per attachment point (ceiling or wall screw), but never more than 10 kg (22 lbs) per shelf.

Example to the right: The shelf has got 4 attachment points (2 wall brackets and screws at the top and 2 at the bottom). The attachment of the shelf, would allow a total of 80 kg (176 lbs), but due to the number of shelves, the maximum weight is 60 kg (132 lbs).
