Thank you for choosing Scoot Boots!

If you have ANY issues with your Scoot Boots, such as boots coming off, twisting or rubbing, it could mean that you have the wrong size boots.

How to care for your Scoot Boots

- Only use water to clean your boots. Avoid any detergents or chemicals as they will damage your boots and your warranty will be voided. Chemicals can be found in wrapping tape, cleaning fluids, fly spray, hoof oils and grease - just to name a few.
- Make sure you store your boots (in the boot bag provided) when they are clean, and hang them in a dry, safe place away from any chemicals. Avoid storing your boots in extreme heat or cold. Taking these precautions will extend the life of your boots.
