You gain influence

Over many issues that affect your daily life in the workplace, the employer must negotiate with the union before making decisions.

If something goes wrong at work, it can be difficult and expensive to resolve the problem on your own. Your union is your expert in labour law and is ready to help when you need it.

As a union member, you gain access to valuable insurance. Insurance cover that you and your family can get at a fraction of the cost of doing it on your own.

The union regularly negotiates with employers to increase salaries in all sectors.

The union promotes issues that safeguard your recovery and well-being and make it easier for you to find time for family, friends and your own interests.
