# The Roof brush TS3 by TAKSOPEN

Now you can finally, and simply, sweep and clean your roof clear of pine needles, leaves and moss ! A Swedish patent and the only one of its kind.

The actual brush part consists of four sticks of aluminum and lined in 30 ppi foam that is adjustable sideways. You can easily set them up to your specific roof, as well as a plastic scraper to help tear bits in the moss as lies in the overlap between the tiles.

The special foam is easy to change for new ones.

The telescopic handle can be pulled out from 1,85 meter up to 6 meters (19,69 ft), and making it easier for you to stand on the ground, or a ladder, and carry out sweeping.

You don't have to put weight on the Roof brush when sweeping, you just put the brush on the roof and gently draw it against you. Easy and smooth without moving or breaking tiles.

If you work standing on the roof, or from a ladder, always make sure you're well secured to avoid accidents.

If you have moss clumps at the edges of the pans; rub back and forth with the Roof brush until it starts dropping moss pieces, or use the scraper and then sweep down the moss/needles. There is also a steelbrush available for the Roof brush.

The thin moss of 3-4 millimeters is more difficult. It can give in after regularly sweeping in the long run, alternatively, you use any kind of eco friendly pesticide on the thin moss after you have swept the roof from trash.

It is easier, safer and faster to sweep with the Roofbrush by Taksopen® !

We recommend regular sweeping of the roof to avoid that moss starts to grow.

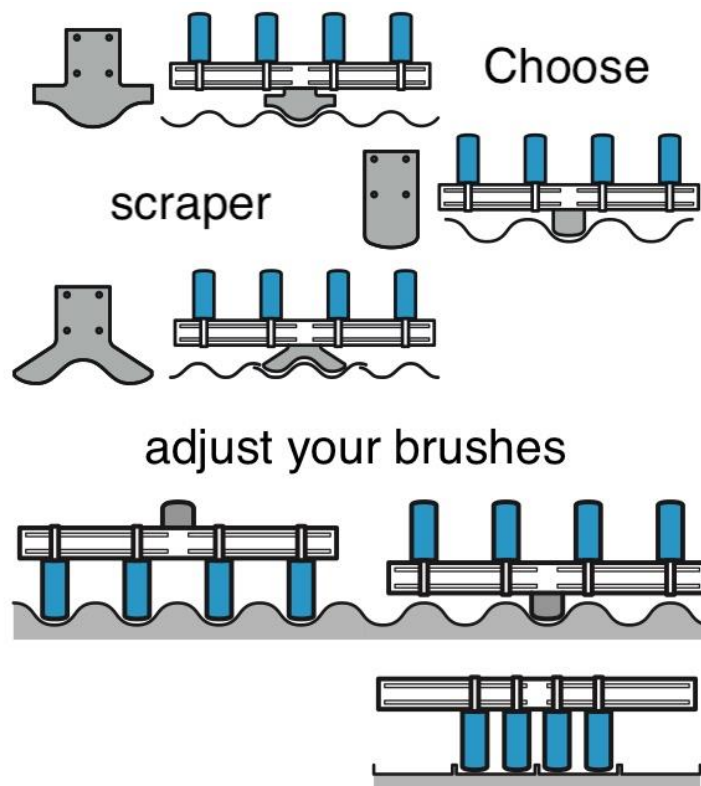
The brush plate is 56 cm (1,83 ft) wide and made of aluminum and stainless steel. The neighbors are likely to be jealous when they see how easy you sweep of the roof!

Includes 4 pcs 30 ppi brushes, 3 different plastic scraper and a 6 m professional telescope pole. Weighs a total of 2,4 kilos.

# HOW TO USE THE ROOF BRUSH;

1. For best results; Use the Roof brush when the rubbish and the thick moss on the roof are dry, not when it is wet or frozen, or have been frozen at night. Best weather conditions are spring summer and autumn, in plus degrees, and where the moss got dried for one or two weeks.
2. Assemble the Roof brush as described.
3. Choose and attach one of the 3 plastic scrapers that suits your roof. Adjust the foam rubber brushes sideways to fit your roof. (If you only use the telescope pole, you can combine 2 of the scrapers and attach them on the shaft mount.)



4. Pull out the telescopic shaft to the desired length. Please keep 10-15 cm left in each tube section for extra strength. Once you have pulled out the shaft to 5-6 meters, it is extra sensitive to bumps and fast movements. Take it easy, sweep and scratch calmly and methodically. Keep in mind that everything that weighs little should also be used with care.
5. Place the Roof brush carefully, and as far as you reach, on the roof and pull downwards, upwards and downwards. Repeat and rub a little where needed. Do you still see moss parts that doesn't release from surface; turn around the Roof brush and scrape a little - turn back and sweep down. You do not have to push, or press, the Roof brush hard against the roof. Rub a little more with the brush where it is needed. See also the film clips at [www.taksopen.se](http://www.taksopen.se)  
We recommend that you sweep the ceiling regularly 2 times every year!
